Scoring is 100 points per specie plus 10 points per KG up to 15kg per individual fish. Individual fish over 15kg shall be awarded the maximum score of 250pts (100pts for specie and 150 points for weight). Each diver may weigh a maximum of one fish per specie.

**#: Category One Fish:** classified as highly vulnerable to overfishing. Maximum mixed daily bag limit of these fish is 4 per diver. Any individual who presents more than 4 Category One fish to the Weigh Master shall be disqualified.

**Note:** "WA Fisheries min size length" column refers to species legal size **NOT** competition minimum size. Competition minimum size is set 20-30% above legal size eg. A 3000g min comp weight Dhufish equates to a 57-59cm fish. This is 7-9cm greater than the WA fisheries min size length of 50cm. Penalties apply under weight fish; see A and B Section rules.
